



MARBLE & TRAVERTINE CARE INSTRUCTIONS

This product is made from natural stone. Both marble and travertine have a natural variation, meaning each stone block differs in color, structure, and veining patterns.

The surfaces are brushed and not treated with additional lacquer to enhance the natural feel of the stone.

To preserve the beauty of these materials and extend their lifespan, proper care is required. Below are some important guidelines:

1. Use protective placemats and coasters to prevent scratches and stains, especially from glass, hot items, or candles.
2. Avoid heavy pressure, as excessive pressure may cause cracks in the stone.
3. Be cautious when using sharp tools directly on the surface and avoid placing heavy or hard objects on the stone to prevent scratches and damage.
4. Remove dust and dirt regularly with a microfiber cloth and use a damp cloth with mild soap or a gentle cleaning solution. Avoid acidic cleaning products, as they can damage the surface.
5. Wipe up spills immediately, especially from acidic substances such as wine, vinegar, and fruit juice. Avoid using products that contain limescale removers, as these can damage the surface.
6. For surfaces that are not treated with additional lacquer, it is recommended to treat the stone with a stone sealant to increase resistance to spills. Repeat the treatment as needed to maintain optimal protection.
